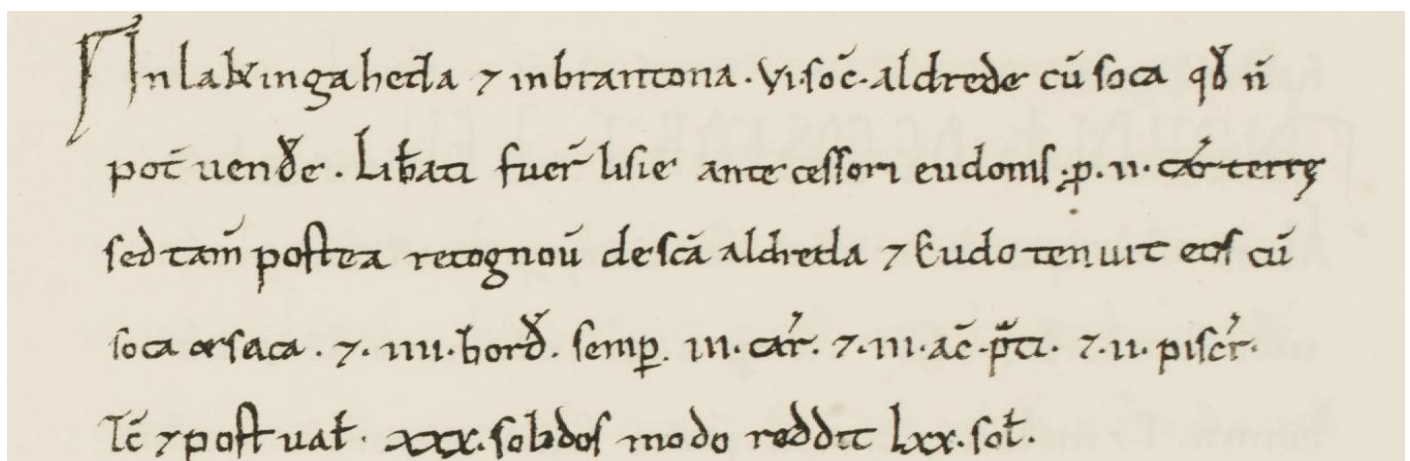
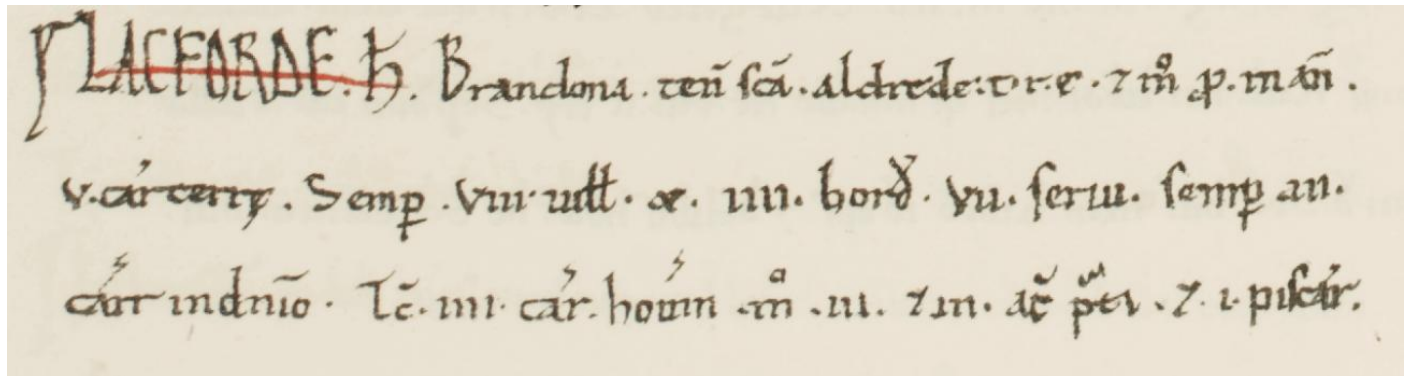
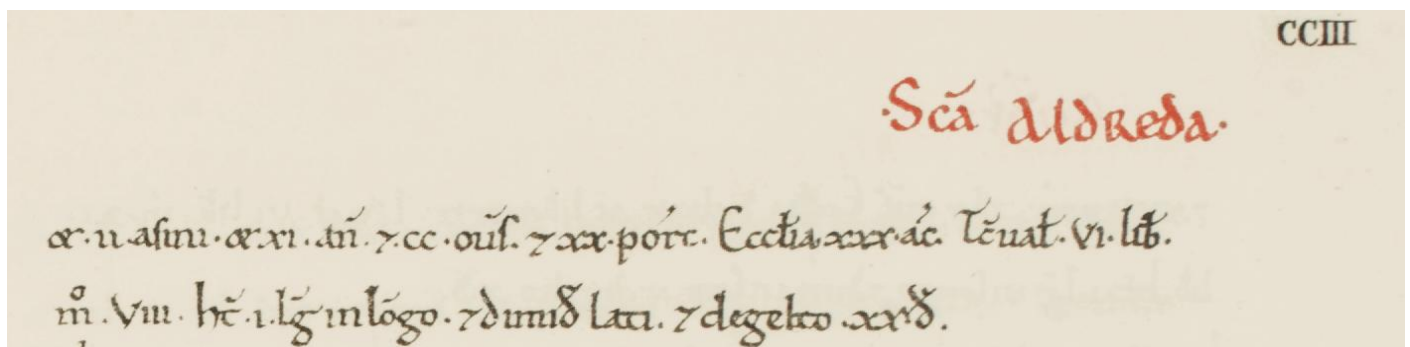


Domesday Book Brandon
